Beginning Chinese II, 5 Credits
(Spring Semester 2010 — Monday, 6:00-8:40 PM)

This is the second semester of a one-year course in Beginning Chinese. As such it continues the general first-semester goals of imparting to students a general understanding of the nature and history of the Chinese language and teaching students to understand and use basic sentence patterns. Specific goals include knowledge of 600-plus vocabulary words and the ability to recognize and write approximately 500 Chinese characters (in both their traditional and simplified forms). Students are also instructed in the use of a radical-based dictionary, Chinese word-processing software, Chinese-language Internet software, and Clavis Sinica, “a Chinese software text reader with a cross-referenced lexical database” that helps students learn both to read better and to master new vocabulary.

This is a web-enhanced course, with 3 classroom and 2 interactive online hours. Students must have access to the Internet (at home, in IHCC library, etc.) in order to complete the online hours.

Completion of Beginning Chinese I, similar knowledge of Chinese, or the consent of the instructor is necessary to take this course.

This course can be used to satisfy the following requirements in Inver Hills Community College degree programs.

1. ‘Minimum of 60-semester credits numbered 1000 or above’ needed to graduate.
2. **Liberal Arts Elective** requirement for Associate in Arts Degree, Associate in Science Degree, Associate in Applied Science Degree, and Associate in Fine Arts Degree; and **Liberal Arts Curriculum** in A.S. in Global Studies.
3. **Minnesota Transfer Curriculum, Goal 8** (Global Perspectives).
