The first time you start WebAssign, you will need to click on "I have a class key!" and register yourself.

Once you have self-enrolled, you will give yourself a username and password (don't forget it!). Each time you login, you will need your username, institution code (inverhills), and password.

You can get your WebAssign Access Code either by:

2. Buying the access code online (you will need to provide credit card info)

Most students have issues with typing in the answers correctly. If you practice the HW, not only will you get practice with how to format your answers correctly, but you will also have access to hints, tutorials and other help on problems that may show up on the quizzes. On some problems, you will need to enter in mathematical symbols. A math toolbar will pop-up for those answers. **Make sure that you read the directions very carefully and enter in the answer in exactly the format that is being requested** (for example, give 4 decimal places or type in DNE if the limit does not exist). If you believe that you were misgraded, then please e-mail me with the problem and answer in question, and I will decide if credit should be given.
