

## Questionnaire for Online Math 1119 College Algebra II

Is online Math 1119 right for you? The following questions can help you decide. For each question, choose the answer that is most appropriate – be honest – then follow the instructions at the bottom of the page. This online math course requires the use of D2L to access course materials including video lectures and MyMathLab software to access online tests, HW and textbook. You are also encouraged to turn in written HW electronically.

**First, answer these three very important questions:**

1. I need to take Math 1133 (Calculus I) for my major or transfer school. No \_\_\_\_\_ Yes \_\_\_\_\_

**If you answered Yes to this question, then you are in the right course and should be taking Math 1119 as either an online, hybrid or face-to-face course.**

**If you answered Yes to this question, then you are NOT in the right course and should be taking Math 1120 (Survey of Calculus) instead. Survey of Calculus is a shorter version of Calculus that does not use trigonometry – often needed by business majors. Math 1119 (College Algebra II) is only needed if you intend on taking a regular trigonometry-based Calculus course like Math 1133.
