- Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Science (B.A./B.S.)
 - Introductory degree in psychology
- Master of Science/Master of Arts (M.S./M.A.)
 - Graduate-level work in psychology
 - Minimum qualification for doing clinical work
- Doctor of Psychology (Psy.D.)
 - Advanced professional degree for clinicians
- Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.)
 - Focuses on either research, or research + practice
