

## MATH 1103 - eBook User Information:

Students who have chosen to use the eBook package that is entirely online need to know where to find the following items all housed in MyStatLab (MSL) Note: MyStatLab and MyMathLab are the same software. Educators frequently refer to the software as MyStatsLab when it is for a statistics course. In general, anything that relates to the textbook package can be found in MSL except the Minitab software.

1. **eBook** is one of the side menu buttons in MSL. Choose the chapter and then the section in the drop-down menu.
2. **Minitab Manual**: from MSL follow the path *Tools for Success* → *Technology Manuals* → *Minitab Manual*
3. **Appendix B data sets** (from the Triola text): The folder containing the Minitab worksheet data sets is one of the items accessed by the *Tools for Success* side menu button when in MSL.
4. **Lecture videos for the text from the publishers**: From within MSL select the side menu button Multimedia Library. Then select the chapter and section in the drop-down menu. Put a check in the boxes of the types of files that you would like to use. You may choose lecture videos or the podcast that can be download to an iPod. Other types of multimedia files are available as well.
5. **Student Solutions Manual**: Select the side menu button *Tools for Success*.
6. **Publisher's Tutor Center**: There is either a side menu button or you will see it at the top of the page within Chapter Contents. This links to information to contact professional math tutors by a toll-free phone number, fax, or e-mail.

**MINITAB**: One of the course objectives in Math 1103 is that students will become proficient in a statistical software (at IHCC this is Minitab). All students may use campus computers in the open labs to do their Minitab homework and assignments. Some students prefer to have Minitab on their own computer for convenience. To have your own Minitab software, go to [www.e-academy.com/minitab](http://www.e-academy.com/minitab) where you can purchase a 6 month license for around \$30 or download a free 30-day license to try it out. Other license agreements are listed at that site. Minitab is NOT MAC compatible. Online students who are MAC users will need to use campus computers for all Minitab work or have access to Minitab that is installed on a PC.
