

Lecture Videos and Guided Notes for Videos

Lecture Videos: Instruction will be provided by lecture videos as well as MyStatLab instructional software. Students may choose from two options for lecture videos on the text content: those offered by the publisher (about 20 minutes per section) and those created by the instructor (20-60 minutes per section). The instructor's videos use the same notes as are used in the traditional classroom lectures. Although they are longer, they have more sample exercises.

- Publisher video lectures in MyStatLab software / Multimedia Library.
- Instructor video lectures in D2L / Content / Instructor Videos & Help/ download the URLs document. Double click the link to go to a particular video lecture in a media player.

Minitab videos: These are similar to the computer Minitab lab classes on campus.

- Minitab video lessons are in D2L / Content / Minitab / download the URLs document. Double click the lesson title to go to it in a media player on your computer.

Guided notes written by the instructor correspond with the videos: These are guided notes that can be printed to help students get more from the videos. Exercises done on the videos are included on the notes. However, students may take their own notes rather than using the outlined notes.

- Lecture notes for the publishers videos can be printed from D2L / Content / *Instructor Videos & Help* folder.
- Minitab notes may help you get more from the Minitab video lessons. The Minitab lecture notes are in the first section of the course pack. They can also be printed from D2L / Content / Minitab.
