

## Math 96-61

Math 96-61 is considered a "hybrid" section because we will use lecture videos viewed in the software (MyMathLab) during the week as part of the homework and self-instruction. So in-class lecture time is reduced to 2 hours per week rather than 3 hours of a traditional class. Also, we will not meet three evenings during the semester: 9/28, 10/26, and 11/23 so there will be 26 hours of instruction and testing compared with 45 hours in a traditional class. Also software will be used extensively outside of class to practice exercises, to take online quizzes and to do chapter reviews and test reviews. Therefore, it is advised that students have off-campus access to a computer and the Internet for their own convenience. However, students may use campus computers if they do not have access elsewhere. Campus computers are available Mon-Thurs 7:30 AM - 9 PM, Fridays 7:30 AM - 4 PM, and Saturdays 9 AM - 3 PM except for holidays and other days that the campus is closed. I suggest that you check computer lab hours around holidays and close to days when classes are not being held as usual. These are posted online at the college website under *Student Resources*.

For success in the class it is essential that students are good time managers and attend all classes as well as do the instructional activities each week preceding the topic mini lecture, study regularly, and do all assigned homework.
